





# COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY (CIL) Form 6: Commencement Notice

**CIL Form 6 Commencement Notice** must be completed and received by Shropshire Council **prior to the commencement of development (ie. at least one day before)** otherwise a surcharge will be applicable. Shropshire Council can only accept notification of commencement on CIL Form 6: Commencement Notice.

For the purposes of CIL, development commences when a material operation in accordance with Section 56(4) of the Town and Country Planning Act (1990) takes place. This Act defines a material operation as:

- (a) Any work of construction in the course of the erection of a building.
- (aa) Any work of demolition of a building.
- (b) The digging of a trench which is to contain the foundations, or part of the foundations, of a building.
- (c) The laying of any underground main or pipe to the foundations, or part of the foundations, of a building or to any such trench as is mentioned in paragraph (b)
- (d) Any operation in the course of laying out or constructing a road or part of a road
- (e) Any change in the use of any land which constitutes material development.

It is the responsibility of the liable party to understand and comply with the CIL Regulations 2010 (as amended) including any eligibility for relief.
