AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Invitation to make further comments

In <u>a Written Ministerial Statement on 1 December 2014</u>, Brandon Lewis MP, Minister of State for Housing and Planning, announced that the Government was making a number of changes to national policy with regard to Section 106 planning obligations. These included the introduction into national policy of a threshold beneath which affordable housing contributions should not be sought.

Preceding this statement, <u>updated and new paragraphs 12-23 were added</u> to the <u>Planning Practice Guidance section on planning obligations</u> as of 28 November 2014.

Core Strategy Policy CS11 (Type and Affordability of Housing) aims to achieve an overall target of 33% local needs affordable housing from all sources of supply.

In light of these changes, the Inspector invited the Council to comment on the implications that these changes would have for the delivery of affordable housing and the soundness of the SAMDev Plan.
