

## Delivery and Monitoring

- 1.11 Continuing the existing approach established in the Core Strategy, the means which will be used to deliver each development management policy ~~are identified~~, together with the indicators which will be used to monitor progress, are identified in boxes at the end of each policy. These indicators form the basis for the accompanying SAMDev Monitoring Framework which identifies policy targets, where relevant; trigger mechanisms for when action might be required to address issues arising through the implementation of policies; and the potential action to be taken by the Council. It also identifies the source of monitoring information.
- 1.12 The pPerformance of the SAMDev policies (and those in the adopted Core Strategy) will be reported annually in the Authority's Monitoring Report (AMR). The AMR ~~provides an assessment of the implementation of policies and up-to-date information about development in Shropshire, which will be used to help inform full or partial reviews of the SAMDev Plan.~~
- 1.13 TThe LDF Implementation Plan and Place Plans identify the infrastructure priorities which are needed to accompany new development to help deliver more sustainable communities. Both the Implementation Plan and Place Plans are regularly reviewed.
