## **Taxpayers stump up £250,000 after Shropshire Council loses day centre court case**

**Shropshire taxpayers have stumped up more than £250,000 after county councillors lost a court case following the closure of a day centre for adults with learning difficulties.**

The figures break down as £115,654 for the council's legal costs, and £136,469 for 80 per cent of the litigant's legal costs, together totalling £252,123. Both are exclusive of VAT. Several Shropshire Council legal staff were also involved in the preparation and presentation of the case, and the cost of their work has not been quantified.
