The inclusion of reference to the Local Development Schedule and for malisation of the timetable for the Local Plan R eview is supported by J Ross Developments. This provides certainty to developers and landholders in terms of the future opportunity to promote sites, whilst a review of housing nee ds can be u ndertaken. The ability t o review the adopted Core Strategy and related site a llocations will ensure consistency with national policy, that lo cal planning policy is re sponsive to changing local needs whilst also being a ble to take into any additional requirements.

The review will allow the opportunity for Green Belt and settlement boundaries to be re-asse ssed, whilst also enabling loca I communities to opt for alternative settlement designation s as Hubs or Clusters so that housing and employment needs can be provided for. The review of boundaries and site allocat ions will also allow for the consideration of newly vacant previously developed land areas to be brought forward.
