The development of this area of land as stated in the report requires appropriate schemes for design and materials, flood alleviation, drainage, tree and woodland protection and ecological, archaeological and landscape character mitigation recognising the situation of the site in relation to the strategic flood plain, the Grove parkland and the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty'.

Wistanstow Parish Council strongly objects to any additional development on the proposed site and strongly supports the outcome of the decision of the Planning Inspectorate in 2004 which was to allow approximately 3ha of land to accommodate the transfer of the abattoir this allowing for reasonable (50%) expansion but not the "value added" processes which form part of the abattoir company's business expansion plan which can and ought to be accommodated on industrial land elsewhere.



The Parish Council are still strongly of the opinion that the Planning Inspectorates view in 2004 is still appropriate:

Additional buildings cannot be reasonably accommodated north of Newington Farm without an unacceptable impact on the landscape and approach to Craven Arms. Furthermore, the parkland to the north of Newington Lodge is a sensitive site visible from the Area of Natural Beauty to the east and it is imperative that the green field area to be developed should be kept to an absolute minimum preferably nil
