The concept of identifying Community Hubs and Clusters is supported.

Allocating Hinstock as a Community Hub is supported. It is a sustainable settlement with a good rage of local services and facilities including a school and shop.

However, the village has been given a housing guideline of just 60 dwellings. This will fail to take full advantage of the available services and will not make the village more sustainable.

The figure of 60 dwellings has been derived from representations made by the Parish Council and is not the result of any objective assessment of the capacity of the village to accept further development.

In order to secure a sensible level of development that will genuinely assist the settlement to become more viable and perhaps achieve a critical mass of persons sufficient to re-instate its bus service, further sites for development need to be added to the list of allocations. OS No's 453 and 454 have a road frontage to the main road running through the village and lie immediately adjacent to the current built up area of the village. The development of this frontage land would not have an adverse effect on any existing residential property. It is within easy walking distance of all the village amenities, including the school and shop.

The potential for extra development in the village should be examined in a dispassionate and objective manner to accurately assess the settlement's capacity to accommodate further development.

OS 453 and 454, which have both good access to the village's amenities as well as having excellent access to the A49 trunk road (which can be accessed without having to drive through the village) should be allocated for housing development. This would bring greater choice to the, market in terms of location and house type, and will make the village more sustainable.
