The concept of allocation of individual sites for housing development is supported.

However, the object of the plan process is to ensure the delivery of the number of houses needed to meet the targets for sustainable development in the County.

At present it appears that just enough dwellings have been constructed, have been granted consent, or exist on allocated sites to meet the number of dwellings calculated as being needed in Shrewsbury. Nevertheless, an excess of the numbers needed is always necessary to allow for dwellings failing to come forward for a variety of reasons. The allocation of land off Holdgate Drive would help towards the achievement of the delivery of the

appropriate number of houses in the town, as it is already in the hands of a developer who is wanting to begin the development as soon as possible. By doing so the development would produce sustainable development and make use of existing services and facilities. Failure to allocate brings with it uncertainty as to whether planning permission will eventually be granted or not. Allocating the land for development in the SAMDev DPD would bring certainty to the housing market.
