Policy MD5 "Sites for sand and gravel working" refers to sites being identified on the Proposals Map and allocated in Schedule MD5a. The available documents are named Policies Maps, rather than Proposals Maps, and we would suggest that the terminology is amended for consistency throughout the suite of documents.

Without intimate local knowledge we also found it difficult to navigate to view the relevant policies maps. We would recommend that Schedule MD5a be amended to include the policy map inset reference numbers for ease of navigation. Whilst we do not consider this is a matter of soundness of the Plan, we feel that this minor change would aid clarity and use of the document.

Sites

Wood Lane North Extension (Ellesmere), Policies Map S8 Inset 8

This proposed site is in the north of the county and therefore we think there are not likely to be any cross-boundary issues in minerals terms with Worcestershire.

Gonsal Extension (Condover), Policies Map S16 Inset 7

This proposed site is in the centre of the county and therefore we think there are not likely to be any cross-boundary issues in minerals terms with Worcestershire.

Morville Extension, Policies Map S3 Inset 5

This proposed site is near Bridgnorth, approximately 9 miles from the county boundary with Worcestershire. Despite this relative proximity, we do not think there are likely to be any direct cross-boundary issues in minerals terms with Worcestershire.

Adequate and steady supply

We support Shropshire Council's positive approach to providing for the adequate and steady supply of sand and gravel through additional site allocations, particularly in view of the three site commitments which have remained unworked.
