The housing allocation to Highley for 2006 to 2026 of 200 houses is far too low to meet economic growth requirements for housing. If 162 houses were built in the years 2006 to 2014 this is 20.25 houses per year. The remaining plan period should provide at least this same number of houses and therefore a further 243 are required up to the period 2026 not a mere 38. Highley is identified as a key centre and the allocation of just 38 houses is inconsistent with that. The plan identifies an insufficient area for the allocation of housing to Highley as a result.

More land should be allocated for housing. We object to the exclusion of Redstone Drive [HIGH 016] from the plan, which is a site suitable for 35/40 houses. This site should be allocated for residential development because it is a natural extension to the village and is adjacent to the centre of the village and will allow an easy walk/cycle to the facilities and the local secondary school. The allocation of the site also opens up a new cycle route from Redstone Drive/the school to the village centre. Additional public open space is also provided with this site. Highley is of an appropriate size to take this additional land for housing.

After this stage you will not be able to make any further representations about the SAMDev Plan to Shropshire Council.
