SamDev plan states: The draft SAMDev Plan has been subject to extensive consultation over several years and the responses have been used to inform the preparation of the draft Final Plan document.

The consultation statement says:

- 2.1 The Shropshire Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) was adopted by the Council in February 2011. The document sets out the broad framework for how Shropshire Council will engage communities and organisations on planning issues across the county, including in the preparation of Planning Policy documents.
- 2.2 The preparation of the SAMDev Plan has followed the consultation principles established in the SCI, and in many cases exceeded them, in particular in the Pre-submission phase of production.

How ever, Statement of Community

Involvement for Shropshire, Adopted version - February 2011 has not been follow ed.

Only less than 4,000 public consultant submissions were received, mainly from companies and public bodies. Private individuals did not have access to written submissions at the road-shows which were held in 2010. Only those already involved in planning issues were invited to contribute. Other 'engaged' Individuals such as those working on local neighbourhood plans, were not included. The consultation is now way out of date as the economy, the NPPF and the latest census would have changed opinions in the past 5 years.

, The Plain English Guide to the Localism Act states:

'Provided a neighbourhood development plan or order is in line with national planning policy, with the strategic vision for the wider area set by the local authority, and with other legal requirements, local people will be able to vote on it in a referendum. If the plan is approved by a majority of those who vote, then the local authority will bring it into force.'

I can find no evidence that any of our local authorities are complying with this. The forthcoming elections in May would be the ideal time to enact this requirement.

This site has been included in error. This schedule states: 'The Cottams, Morda Road (OSW030)

Development subject to the retention of land adjoining the River Morda as open space to maintain the important physical gap to Morda village (this site is in Osw estry Rural Parish).'

Any development here would not be able to retain the land adjoining the River Morda as open space and maintain the important physical gap to Morda village. As stated the site is not in Osw estry Town and should not be included in this schedule. The Local Parish Plan is still in preparation and will not include development on this site when published.

Over 125 detailed objections to any development on this site have been submitted.

The development boundary of this site is also in error and subject to the decision of the High Court of Justice 3rd April 2000 Between Jennings Homes Ltd. and Oswestry Borough Council and should be considered by the inspector.

Any development here is unsustainable, contrary to NPPF, especially given the current permissions given for current and proposed building in the area. The local and wider infrastructure is already unable to manage current demands. That is one of the reasons why earlier proposals for this site where rejected and it should not have been included in the SamDev draft documents.
